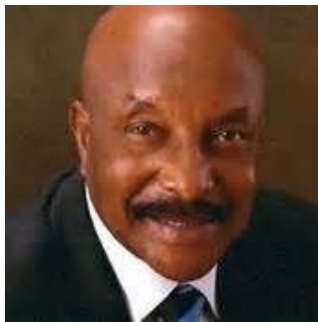
Joseph McCray Sr. (Mighty Joe) is endorsed by Republicans of River City for Congress for the Sixth Congressional District.

A few weeks ago I got a message from the California Morning Report (<http://www.capitolmr.com/home.asp>) thanking us for sending them our Republicans of River City weekly calendar of Republican events.

While stopping in at the Carmichael post office, the publisher of six weekly newspapers in the county stopped

me and said although he didn't have room in his newspapers for all of the news items we were sending him, he wanted to thank us and asked me to keep sending him news releases and information about Republican events.

Also this last week we started adverting on Rough and Tumble (<http://www.rumble.com>), one of the most widely read daily news blogs concerning what is happing in California. Last month R&T had over 300,000 page views.

We are running the ad on Rough and Tumble in order for voters up and down the state of California to become aware of the candidates we have endorsed for the June 3 Primary election.

Over 4,000 pageviews came from individuals in Washington DC, 25,626 came from the Los Angeles area and about same number from the bay area and San Diego had almost 9,000.

Next week (May 22 – 27) Republicans of River City will have a booth at the Sacramento County Fair where over 90,000 individuals will have an opportunity to stop by and register to vote and get information on the candidates you and other members of Republicans of River City endorsed. The County Fair is the last major event taking place in Sacramento County before the June 3 election.

Our Republicans of River City calendar of events is emailed each week to over 5,000 individuals across our state.

Please keep in mind that each month we have tables, chairs and other supplies at the monthly Northern California New Citizens ceremony so we can register new citizens to vote. The next ceremony is May 20 at Raley field

in West Sacramento. In addition, we ask our club volunteers to turn out so we can have a presence at many local community events.

All these efforts are to help advance the Republican Party and could not be accomplished without the support of your membership dues and gifts.

Small businesses employers create about half of all private sector jobs and create more than half of the nonfarm private gross domestic product in the Sacramento area.

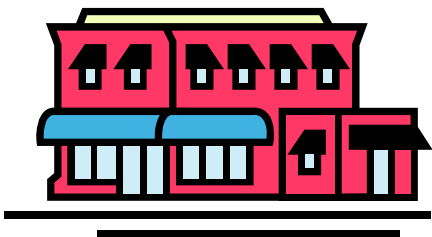

- May 10, 1866** - U. S. House passes Republicans' 14th Amendment guaranteeing due process and equal protection of the laws to all citizens; 100% of Democrats vote NO.
- May 22, 1856** - For denouncing Democrats' pro-slavery policy, Republican U. S. Senator Charles Summer (R-MA) is beaten nearly to death on the floor of the Senate by U. S. Representative Preston Brooks (D-SC).

COMING SOON - THE SELF DRIVING CAR

An SUV pulls to the left, creating a buffer as it passes a bicyclist in the bike lane on a busy afternoon not far from Google headquarters in Silicon Valley.

That's not exceptional except the car is Google's self driving car.

Google's self-driving car is a project to end human error behind the wheel using Google software. These self driving cars have logged more than 700,000 hours since Google began working on the vehicles in 2009. Google expects to have them ready for public use between 2017 and 2020.

The goal is to have safe cars. Not

only are more than 33,000 people killed annually in the US in car crashes, but such accidents are the leading cause of death for people under the age of 45.

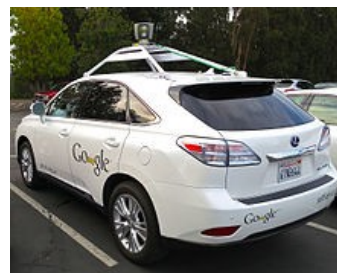
How does it work? The heart of the self driving system is a Google topographical map that helps tell the car what to expect. The map contains information such as the height and location of traffic signals, where the stop signs and crosswalks are located, the location of the sidewalk and curb, the width of the road and each of the lanes, the lane markings, and more. In addition, the self driving car "sees" using laser and camera systems. Then the car puts all the data through machine learning software to decide two things - how fast to go and which way to turn the steering wheel.

Want one? Me too.

But, a self-driving car raises questions:

How do you insure a self-driving car? Who pays if a self driving car is in a crash? If pulled over for speeding, can the occupants avoid a ticket by saying nobody was driving officer; we were all in the back seat? Can someone with a suspended license "drive" a self driving car? What about people convicted of DUI—can they have a self driving car? Is it possible to prevent a hacker from breaking into the software and changing the way the car operates?

It's fun to live in interesting times.
