
This debate will be extra special for Californian Republicans as it will take place at the Ronald Reagan Presidential Library in Simi Valley.

LETS ROLL

Bingham, a gay public relations executive and sportsman - two very different men sitting in first class - came together along with two other successful men, Jeremy Glick and Tom Burnett, and working with other passengers on Flight 93, became America heroes with the words "Lets roll."

Beamer tried to make a call from the hijacked and doomed United Airlines Flight 93, scheduled from Newark to San Francisco, to his wife. Beamer, who didn't want to worry his pregnant wife, had called GTC, the company that provides the telephone service on United Airlines flights. He and Lisa Jefferson, a telephone switchboard operator, talked for about 13 minutes, during which they recited together the Lord's Prayer and Psalm 23 - 'Though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; for Thou art with me; Thy rod and Thy staff they comfort me."

Mark Bingham was last to board the plane, having arrived late and nearly missing the flight, was sitting in same row as Beamer. Bingham was a 6 foot 5 rugby player who had run with the bulls in Pamplona, Spain and once

No one will ever know how the plan to attack the terrorists was hatched, except for an indication; an analysis of the recording of Beamer's call indicated that the scuffle began not at the back of the plane but at the front - where Bingham, Beamer, Glick and Burnett were sitting.

And Lisa Jefferson overhears on her phone Beamer saying "You ready, Okay, LETS ROLL."

situation on flight 93 made the supreme sacrifice and saved hundreds of lives is the reason that they became emblems of heroism.

September 11, 2001 Attack on America:

8:45 a.m. - American Flight 11, crashes into the north tower of the World Trade Center: 9:03 a.m. - United Flight 175 crashes into the south tower of the World Trade Center; 9:43 a.m. -American Flight 77 hit the Pentagon; 10:05 a.m. - The south tower of the World Trade Center collapses: 10:10 a.m. - A portion of the Pentagon collapses; 10:10 a.m. - United Airlines Flight 93 crashes in Pennsylvania; 10:28 a.m. - The World Trade Center's north tower collapses; 10:45 a.m. - All federal office buildings in Washington are evacuated; 6:54 p.m. - President Bush arrives back at the White House and speaks to the American people at 8:30 pm.
